



Anti-theft marking

Anti-theft marking installation guidelines

Security features:

The ideal amount of markings installed is **50**. This amount may be limited by vehicle type. In fact, a basic two door sub-compact will have fewer parts to mark than a mini-van or luxurious S.U.V.

Areas that must be marked:

- All windows: Windshield, rear window, side windows and decorative glass.
- Headlamps, side markers (all), flashers (all), brake lamps and fog lamps.
- The engine and engine compartment components.
- Other major mechanical components (ex: transmission)
- Body parts such as: Hood, Trunk, doors, grilles and bumpers.
- Alloy wheels and hubcaps
- In general, all parts susceptible to be stripped and resold.

The computerized V.I.C. (vehicle identification code):

- The **V.I.C.** engraved on the vehicle is unique. This code is entered in our database as soon as it is registered by the dealer. Our database contains the following information:
 - *Customer name.*
 - *The vehicle make, model and year.*
 - *The vehicle V.I.N (Vehicle Identification Number).*
 - *The Dealer or authorized installer's name.*
 - *The installation date.*
- **The database information is transferable** to any subsequent owner of the vehicle.
- **Our database is only accessible** to **Police** and **Insurance companies** via our website's secure extranet access.

Quality control:

- **We provide all the necessary training** when a new dealer joins our program and provide the same training when a new employee joins the dealership.
- We also re-train dealership staff when an inspection scored less than **90%** compliance with our guidelines.
- **Severely damaged vehicles** that have been rebuilt will not be registered in our database without being identified as authentic by the Insurance Bureau of Canada (IBC) by an official document. In this specific case, dealers must also provide a copy of the vehicle's registration certificate that will be destroyed after verification.
- **Surprise inspections** are scheduled randomly to assure quality of our product. When a dealer fails an inspection, their staff will be re-trained and we will closely monitor their performance. In case of repeated unsatisfactory inspections the establishment will lose its license to sell our Anti-theft marking.
